PARKING OPTIONS

Parking Garages and Daily-Fee Lots

Accessible spaces are located in various campus lots and garages. Extra-wide spaces for vans with side-loading lifts are available in most areas. A state-issued placard or license plate for persons with disabilities is required to park in all accessible spaces. All accessible parking follows the same fee rules as the other campus lots and spaces. Payment is required upon parking 24/7, 365 days a year.

Special Event rates will be implemented on a regular basis in all campus lots and garages. The rate structure will be in effect Monday–Thursday evenings after 5 p.m., and all day on weekends, Friday–Sunday. Be sure to register your vehicle with Parking and Transportation Services to ensure you pay the daily fee rate.

Pre-Paid Permits

A pre-paid permit valid for all accessible spaces on campus (except metered spaces) may be purchased at a discounted rate.

Accessible permit-only spaces are available in the Elm, Holly, and Spruce lots, as well as between the Library and Science Building. Purchase of the permit, however, does not guarantee the right to park in an assigned space. If all of the spaces in a permit-only area are full, please use another permit area or a general accessible daily-fee space.

To obtain a permit, present your registration for a state-issued placard or proof of a license plate for persons with disabilities to the Parking & Transportation Services office. Permits are purchased on a semester basis and are available one week prior to the start of classes.

Metered Parking

A state-issued placard or license plate for persons with disabilities is required to park at accessible meters. The meters accept coins and credit cards; a pre-paid permit is not valid in a metered space. Payment is required 24/7, 365 days a year.

Daily-Fee Parking Garages

The Tivoli Parking Garage, 7th Street Garage, and 5th Street Garage offer daily-fee spaces for persons with disabilities. To pay, use the pay machine or pay-by-phone app (license plate # needed).

5th Street Garage: \$6

- Electric car charging available

7th Street Garage: \$7.50

Friday: 6:30 a.m.–5:30 p.m.
Saturday & Sunday: Closed (*except for special events*)

Temporary Disabilities

Persons with temporary disabilities should present the Parking & Transportation Services office with a physician's statement indicating that close proximity parking is required. With this documentation, a temporary parking pass for persons with disabilities will be issued, which allows use of accessible daily-fee.

Campus Accessible Shuttle | 303-556-2001

The Campus Accessible Shuttle (CAS) service provides free transportation for campus students, faculty, and staff with disabilities. Call 303-556-2001 to request a ride, or download the TapRide App to request a ride in real-time. See map for pick-up locations.

Students with disabilities are required to register with their institution's disability services office. All other campus community members need to register with Parking & Transportation Services. Once registered, a campus ID decal will be issued. An ID with a decal is required to ride the CAS.

All students, faculty, staff, or campus visitors with temporary disabilities may visit the Parking & Transportation Services office for short-term CAS validation.

Motorist Assistance Program | 303-556-2000

(must be parked in an Auraria Campus lot or garage)
Parking staff are available to jump-start vehicle batteries and assist with changing flat tires. Jumper cables, tire tools, and water are also available at no charge.
