Whether it's a facilities concern, a suspicious item, or unusual behavior, your willingness to speak up helps keep our campus safe, functional, and resilient.

Below are simple ways *you can help us help you*.

### **See an Issue? Contact Facilities Services**

The Auraria Campus Facilities team is here to address maintenance concerns. Reporting issues early helps prevent injuries, equipment failures, and property damage.

#### **Please contact Facilities if you notice:**

- Water leaks, flooding, or water on the floor
- Broken doors, windows, locks, or access issues
- Power outages or flickering lights
- Heating or cooling problems
- Damaged sidewalks, handrails, stairways, or trip hazards
- Any maintenance issue that appears unsafe or out of place

#### **Contact ACPD if you observe:**

- A **concerning or unattended item** (bag, box, backpack, etc.)
- Suspicious behavior or activity
- Someone who appears to be in crisis or distress
- A crime in progress or a potential threat
- Safety concerns involving people, vehicles, or unusual circumstances
