## AGENDA

- Approval of Agenda and Minutes 10.6.17 and 9.29.17
  Emily moved to approve the minutes from 9/29 and 10/6. Mayra seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.
- □ New Business
  - a. Emily's Line Item

A student came in with a complaint about a slave ship sculpture that is outside the Auraria library. The students were offended by the sculpture and wanted more information about it. Emily proposed that SACAB either put up an informational plaque to add context to the sculpture or ask that it be moved off campus, although she admits the latter is a little

dramatic. Several other students were also confused as to the meaning of this art work. Ariel will gather information for the group on this topic.

b. Ola's Line Item

Ola had an idea for a secured skateboard rack so that students don't have to carry around a skate board all day during classes. Emily thought that this could possibly be a SCP project since it pertains to alternative transportation. Chris said that he would look into the possibility of adding this to the secured bike parking areas that are currently in the planning phases.

#### c. Halloween Contest & Haunted Harvest

SACAB traditionally puts on a Halloween office decorating contest in the Tivoli. They decided they would like to continue this tradition. They will need to find judges for the competition and decide on a date for judging. SACAB will hand out fliers to inform the Tivoli tenants.

Frida called for a motion to approve a budget not exceed \$200 for a pizza party for the office that wins the Halloween office decorating competition. Emily moved and Ola seconded. **The motion passed unanimously.** 

Haunted Harvest is a 9<sup>th</sup> street house decorating contest put on by CCD each year. The event will take place on Thursday the 26<sup>th</sup> from 3:00pm to 6:00pm, but SACAB could begin decorating the house earlier if they wish.

Ola will create flyers for the Tivoli office decorating contest, so the group can distribute these.

For tabling at the end of the month, the group will need candy. The group also looked at some options for a new tablecloth that includes the updated SACAB logo. They decided on a dyed tablecloth. Ariel will bring back a formal quote for approval next week.

d. Role Delegation

Frida requested that Mayra set up a meeting with the food pantry to talk about AHHA week. Additionally, if there are student org events, SACAB should try to attend and get student feedback. There are still some issues with event applications, but SACAB will consider putting on a workshop for student orgs in the spring, to highlight process, and talk about any other issues they are having; what's working and what isn't, etc. Advertising for the spring workshop will be held a month in advance.

#### e. AHHA Update

Chris got a quote from Blackboard Eats for pizza on Wednesday and pasta on Thursday. A formal proposal hasn't been approved yet, but Chris will get one before next week's meeting. Tables are booked prior to the event to spread the word about the event and to get survey information for the digital display.

- Position Announcements
  - SGA: MSU Denver: they have a couple positions open in SGA. Take Back the Night week is approaching as well as Campus Safe Night on Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. Campus-con is next weekend and takes place the 21st and 22nd. Saturday, programming runs from 7:30am-5:00pm and Sunday runs from 7:30am to 3:00pm.

CCD: they are having a leadership conference at Front Range. Additionally, they will be working with MSU on the Take Back the Night week festivities.

CU Denver: they are doing giveaways and trying to run an outreach campaign for their SGA. UCD is still talking with Marcus on the addition of bike trails on campus.

- ABOD: No update. They will have their annual workshop on November 1<sup>st</sup>. Only Board members are asked to go to this off campus meeting.
- PODSOC: No update. They will meet on 10/26.
- FSAC: A recycling bin is jammed or broken behind Dazbog and needs to be looked at. FSAC has been having feedback meetings with campus vendors.
- SCP: SCP is going to a conference tomorrow and has been talking about the secured biking lots and additional solar projects.
- Campus Update Ariel Redell/Rob Byers: The new smoking maps are printed with the new logo on them. Ariel will drop them in the SACAB office next week.

#### Device Comment

Antwaun Johnson, an MSU Denver student who is also a current SCP member, voiced a concern that Jesus was sitting on both SACAB and SCP and was planning to vote in both committees. Antwaun also told the group about his concerns regarding a 2011 solar project on the Arts Building. He was confused about where the payback from that project was going. He believes that the current institutional presidents and the SGA's aren't interested in investing in sustainable projects and he feels that there is a disconnect between SCP and the rest of campus leadership. He wants there to be more communication. He thinks that the students need a louder voice in sustainability projects because they're funding SCP. Antwaun also requested a copy of the SCP referendum that was passed in 2016 and the names of the students who were involved, if possible. Ariel will work on finding the documents requested and she will work with Emily, SCP Chair, to come up with a plan for Jesus and the rest of SCP.
