PARKING OPTIONS

Parking Garages and Daily-Fee Lots

Payment is required upon parking 24/7, 365 days a year. Accessible spaces are located in various campus lots and garages. Extra-wide spaces for vans with side-loading lifts are available in most areas. A state-issued placard or license plate for persons with disabilities is required to park in all accessible spaces. All accessible parking follows the same fee rules as the other campus lots and spaces.

Evening/weekend rates will be implemented on a regular basis in all campus lots and garages. The rate structure will be in effect Monday–Thursday evenings after 5 p.m., and all day on weekends, Friday–Sunday. Be sure to register your vehicle with Parking and Transportation Services to ensure you pay the daily fee rate.

Pre-Paid Permits

A pre-paid permit valid for all accessible spaces on campus (except metered spaces) may be purchased at a discounted rate.

Accessible permit-only spaces are available in the Fifth Street Garage, Seventh Street Garage, Tivoli Parking Garage, Fir, Elm, Holly, and Spruce lots, as well as at the Facilities Annex, Library, Science, and Cherry Creek Buildings. Purchase of the permit, however, does not guarantee the right to park in an assigned space. If all of the spaces in a permit-only area are full, please use another accessible permit area or a general accessible daily-fee space.

To obtain a permit, present your registration for a stateissued placard or proof of a license plate for persons with disabilities to the Parking & Transportation Services office. Due to the documentation requirement, **online sales are unavailable**. Permits are purchased on a semester basis and are available one week prior to the start of classes.

Metered Parking

A state-issued placard or license plate for persons with disabilities is required to park at accessible meters. The meters accept coins and credit cards; a pre-paid permit is not valid in a metered space. Payment is required 24/7, 365 days a year.

Daily-Fee Parking Garages

The Tivoli Parking Garage, 7th Street Garage, and 5th Street Garage offer daily-fee spaces for persons with disabilities. To pay, use the pay machine or pay-by-phone app (license plate # needed). Paystations do not issue change. Please pay exact amount.

Hours


Monday-Friday: 7:30 a.m.-6 p.m.
